Belief in the Holy Books: the Tautat (including the first five books of the Old Testament, the Book of Psalms and the Holy Koran).

Belief in the day of judgment and a new life after death

Belief that all that happens, good or bad, has been decided by God.

There are five duties that I must fulfill as a Muslim:

- Constantly to repeat the Creed: "There is no God but Allah and Mohammed is his prophet."
- 2. Pray 3-5 times a day, first at sunrise, then at midday, mid- afternoon, sunset and at night usually before going to bed.



- 4. Fasting during the month of Ramadan
- 5. Making a pilgrimage to Mecca at least once in my life time to pay homage to the birthplace of Mohammed.

I have the holy-book for Islam, the Koran, which I usually read each evening. This book provides guidance for achieving real happiness in my life and eternal life after death.

We Muslims do not eat pork because it is unclean. We do not eat blood or the meat of any animal which has died through disease or other natural causes, except fish and grasshoppers. We do not drink any alcohol and insist that all meat to be used for food is slaughtered according to the laws of Islam."
