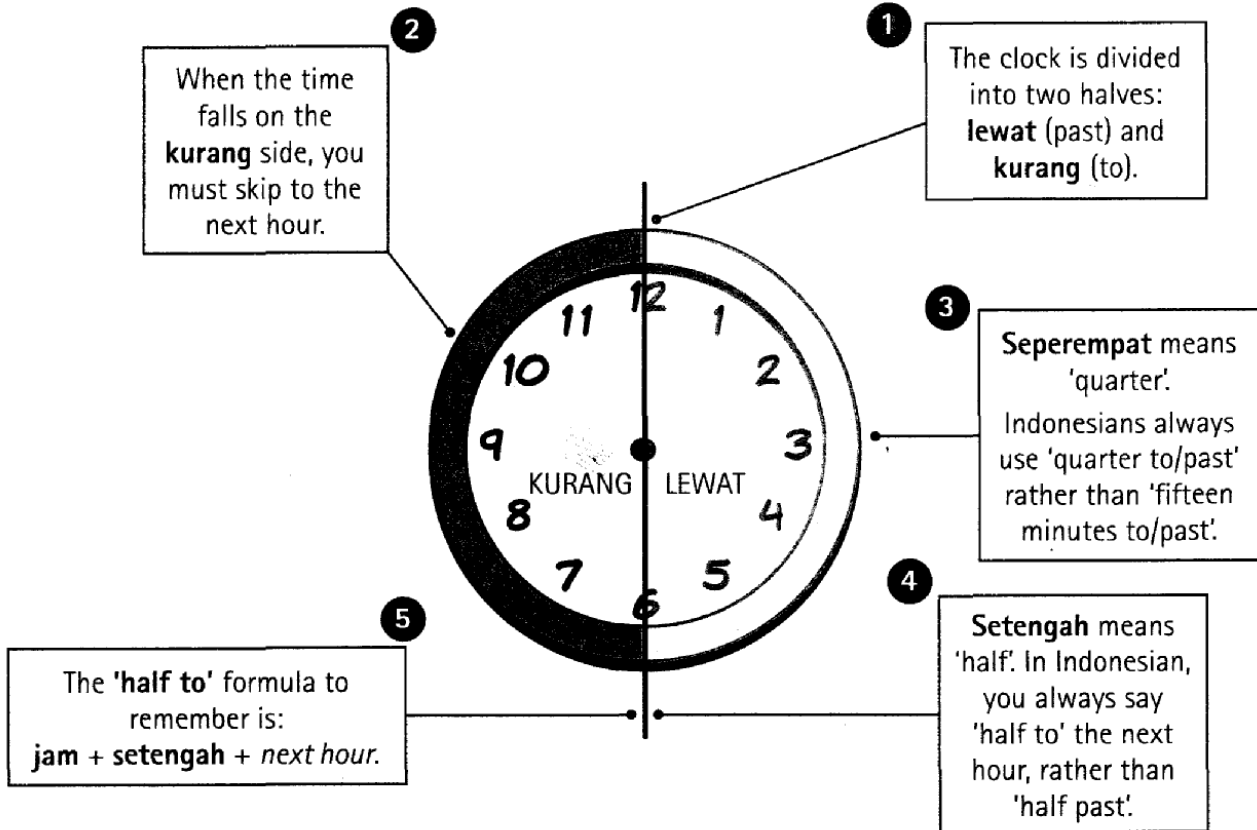


# Jam berapa sekarang?

## What time is it now?

Take a look at the clock below to learn how to express specific times in Indonesian.



Here is a formula to help you give specific times in Indonesian. It may seem like you're telling the time backwards, but follow it, and you'll always get the time right!

$$\text{jam} + (\text{hour}) + \frac{\text{kurang}^*}{\text{lewat}} + (\text{minutes})$$

\*Remember, if you're on the **kurang** side of the clock you skip to the *next* hour.
