

## Locating places

The Indonesian word for a map is **peta**.

As with maps in Australia, official Indonesian maps require the following elements:

<b>Judul peta</b>	A title
<b>Skala peta</b>	The map scale
<b>Lambang peta</b>	The map symbols, such as roads, rivers, capital cities and railways
<b>Garis pinggir peta</b>	An outer border line
<b>Petunjuk arah mata angin</b>	A compass showing the directions

## Locations

To indicate spaces or locations you can use locative prepositions such as **dalam** (inside), **luar** (outside), **atas** (top part), **bawah** (bottom part), **depan/hadapan** (front), **belakang** ((back/rear), **samping** (side), **sebelah** (side when it is followed by some more precise orientation), **antara** (between) and **seberang** (opposite side).

These locatives are usually preceded by the preposition **di**, **ke** or **dari** and are often followed by another noun. There are four common patterns for expressing location in Indonesian:

### I.

OBJECT 1	ada	PREPOSITION	OBJECT 2.
<b>Ruang kelas bahasa</b>	<b>ada</b>	<b>di samping</b>	<b>ruang komputer.</b>
The language classroom	is located	next to	the computer room.

### II.

PREPOSITION	OBJECT 2	ada	OBJECT 1.
<b>Di samping</b>	<b>ruang komputer</b>	<b>ada</b>	<b>ruang kelas bahasa.</b>
Next to	the computer room.	there is	a language class room.

### III.

Ada	OBJECT 1	PREPOSITION	OBJECT 2.
<b>Ada</b>	<b>ruang kelas bahasa</b>	<b>di samping</b>	<b>ruang komputer.</b>
There is	a language class room	next to	the computer room.

### IV.

Letaknya	OBJECT 1	ada	PREPOSITION	OBJECT 2
<b>Letaknya</b>	<b>ruang kelas bahasa</b>	<b>ada</b>	<b>di samping</b>	<b>ruang komputer</b>
The location of	of the language class room	is	next to	the computer room

Indonesians frequently use **terletak** (is located) instead of **ada** when expressing the location of cities, towns and villages. This is also generally the case when expressing street locations for fixed structures such as buildings.

For example:

**Gajah Mada Plaza terletak di Jl. Hayam Wuruk.**

Gajah Mada Plaza is located in Hayam Wuruk Street.

### **Ada ..... to be located or there is/are**

You have already learnt two common uses of **ada** as in the examples:

**Sekolah Harapan Bangsa ada di Jakarta Barat.**

The Pelita Harapan Bangsa school is located in West Jakarta  
and

**Ada banyak siswa di sekolah itu.**

There are many students at that school.

**Ada** serves several other useful functions that you will be exposed to in future worksheets but, for the time being, the above two functions will be consolidated.


### **Exercises**

Below you will find a map of the town of Jebres in West Java and sentences describing the location of places on that map. Match the location descriptions with the corresponding number on the map and write the answer in the space provided.
