Exercise 2

Sample answers:

2.1 Are there any questions on the enrolment form you would not expect to be on a form for Australian public schools?

I would not expect to see a section on 'Religion' to be included on a school enrolment form in a state school in Australia.

2.2 Why would these details be omitted from an Australian enrolment form?

In Australia someone's religion is usually a private matter, which people often prefer not to discuss. In Indonesia, all citizens are required to state one officially recognised religion, *agama*, on all official forms.

2.3 Would it be important for Peter to complete these sections?

It is frowned upon in Indonesia if someone claims to be an atheist and the rather derogatory term *kafir*, non-believer, is used to describe such people.

Exercise 4

Sample answer:

4.1 Anna has completed the application to open an account; what else must she do?

Anna is required to obtain a photocopy of her identity documentation, which in her case will be her passport. A photocopy can be obtained at any of the many photocopy shops or stalls found near schools throughout Jakarta. Once Anna has obtained a photocopy of her passport, she needs to take this along to the bank with her application form.

4.2 Are there any other facts or procedures she needs to be aware of?

According to the application form, her BCA card should be available for collection within seven working days of her submitting her application at the branch where she opened her account.

4.3 Do you think Anna will encounter any difficulties?

If the card is not collected within three months, it will be destroyed by the bank.

4.4 What strategies could she use to overcome these difficulties?

Anna should not really have any difficulties with the process as it is straightforward; however, it could be helpful to ask one of her Indonesian friends to come to the bank with her when she opens her account, and when she returns one week later to collect her BCA card.
