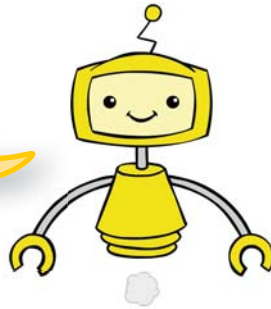


Maybe yes ... maybe no

Maybe or maybe not

You have already learnt that *tidak mungkin* means 'not possible' or 'impossible'.
By reversing the order of *tidak* and *mungkin*, that is, ***mungkin tidak***, the meaning becomes 'maybe not' or 'might not'.

For example:

Apakah dia akan datang ke pesta?

Is he coming to the party?

Mungkin tidak. *Dia harus belajar untuk ulangan.*

Maybe not. He has to study for an exam.

Hopefully ...

▶ To express hope, use ***mudah-mudahan*** meaning 'hopefully'.

For example:

Mudah-mudahan *aku bisa datang ke pesta.*
Hopefully I will be able to come to the party.

▶ Add *tidak* to say 'I hope not'.

For example:

Apakah ada ulangan besok?
Is there an exam tomorrow?

Mudah-mudahan tidak. *Aku belum belajar.*
I hope not. I haven't studied yet.

▶ A slightly more formal way of expressing hope in written language is to use the synonym ***semoga***.

For example:

Semoga *Allah memelihara kita semua.*
May God take care of us all.

Semoga *cepat sembuh.*
Hopefully you have a speedy recovery.







Read Peter's diary.

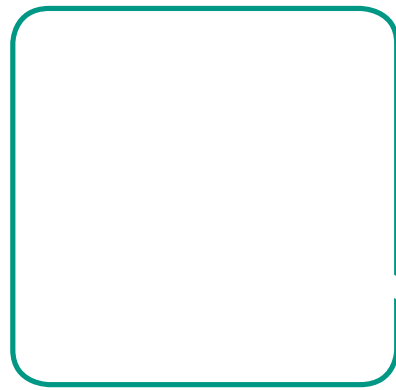
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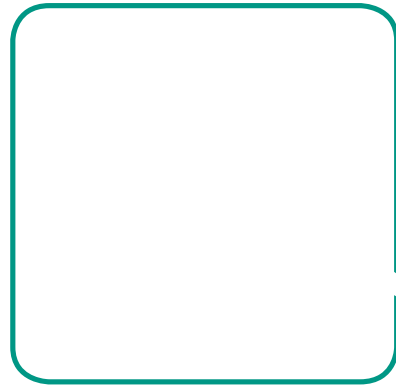
