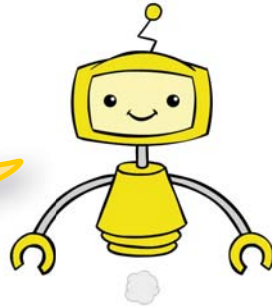


What's your favourite place in Jakarta?

Learning Object 4: Where is it?

Favourite places

1

In Module 9, Learning Object 4, *Where is it?*, Peter introduced Ardi to three of his favourite places in Queensland.

1. Tempat penggalian dinosaurus Eromanga:

- *Jaraknya kira-kira 300 kilometer di sebelah barat Charleville.*
- *Dinosaurus terbesar di Australia ditemukan di sini.*
- *Kamu bisa menggali fosil dinosaurus di sini.*

2. Hutan Tropis Daintree:

- *Jaraknya kira-kira 100 kilometer di sebelah utara Cairns.*
- *Hutan tropis terbesar di Australia.*
- *Kamu bisa berolahraga jalan kaki di sini.*

3. Pulau Moreton:

- *Jaraknya kira-kira 60 kilometer di sebelah timur laut Brisbane.*
- *Pulau pasir terbesar ketiga di dunia.*
- *Kamu bisa meluncur dari bukit pasir di sini.*

To talk about distance:

▶ **sekitar** can be used to say 'around about' and

▶ **kurang-lebih** or **kira-kira** can be used to say 'approximately'.

For example:

... **sekitar** 300 kilometer

... **around** 300 kilometres

... **kurang-lebih** 60 kilometer

... **approximately** 60 kilometres

To describe Moreton Island as being the third-largest sand island in the world, the ordinal number *ketiga* is used in the phrase *pulau pasir terbesar ketiga di dunia*.

Note:

The ordinal number can be positioned on either side of the adjective so Moreton Island could also be described as *pulau pasir ketiga terbesar di dunia*.

Ready, willing and able

To say that one has the capacity to do something, you can use the auxiliary verbs **bisa** (can) or **dapat** (able to).

For example:

*Kamu **bisa** menggali fosil dinosaurus di sini.*

You **can** dig for dinosaur fossils here.

*Kamu **dapat** menjelajah di hutan di sini.*

You **are able** to go bushwalking here.

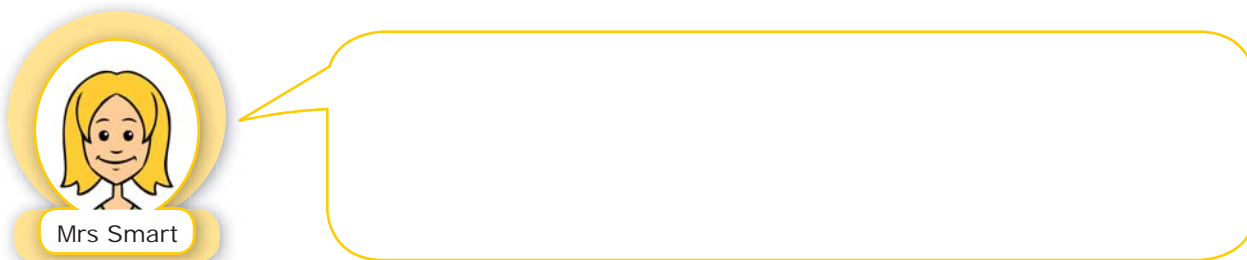

3.3.1 Pak Sugianto

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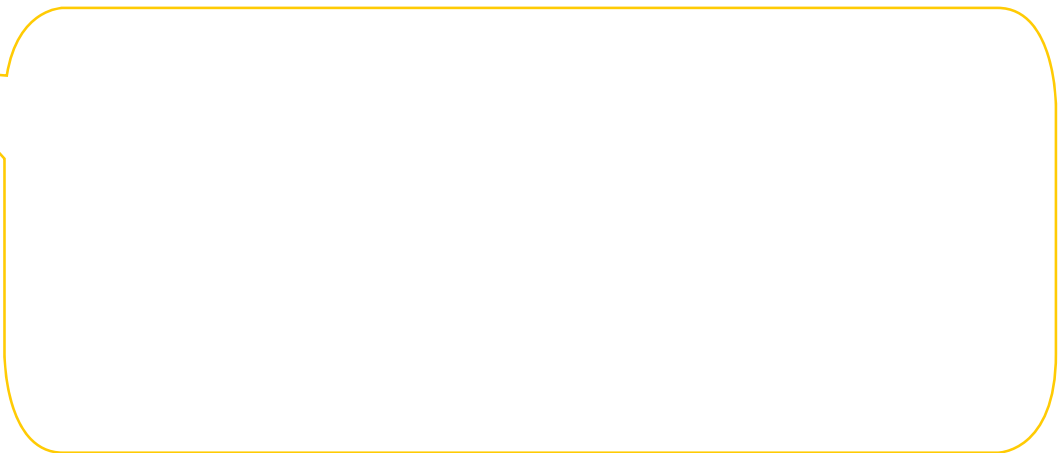
