

Who does what where?

In previous worksheets, you have seen how *orang* was used to refer to people.

For example:

<i>Ada orang di pintu.</i>	There is someone at the door.
<i>Orang itu berkacamata.</i>	That person is wearing glasses.
<i>Orang bisa bermain layang-layang di Taman Merdeka.</i>	People can fly kites in Merdeka Square.

STATING A PERSON'S OCCUPATION:

Now, we are going to see how *orang* is used as a 'classifier'. In Indonesian grammar, a 'classifier' is a word that is used to count or categorise people, other living things and objects.

In this worksheet, we will look at the 'classifier' for people. It is made up of the prefix *se-* and the word *orang*. The resulting 'classifier' *seorang* is most frequently used to say what a person's occupation is.

For example:

<i>Dia seorang dokter.</i>	She is a doctor.
<i>Orang itu seorang polisi.</i>	That person is a police officer.
<i>Saya seorang pelayan restoran.</i>	I am a waiter.

Notice that *seorang* comes **before** the name of the occupation.

SAYING WHERE PEOPLE WORK OR STUDY:

To say what profession, job or study someone does in a particular place, use the following structure.

Subject	Verb	Place
<i>Seorang dokter</i>	<i>bekerja</i>	<i>di rumah sakit.</i>
<i>Seorang mahasiswa</i>	<i>belajar</i>	<i>di universitas.</i>

Throughout this module you have seen the names of various places in a neighbourhood where people work or study.

For example:

<i>restoran</i>	restaurant
<i>toko musik</i>	music shop
<i>bank</i>	bank
<i>toko roti</i>	bakery
<i>kantor pos</i>	post office
<i>swalayan</i>	supermarket
<i>rumah sakit</i>	hospital
<i>Sekolah Menengah Pertama</i>	Junior High School
