

# My plans for the week

In previous modules, you learnt words that are used to refer to time, such as **pada** (in, on, at), **besok** (tomorrow), **hari** (day) and **jam** (o'clock). In this worksheet you will practise using all of these words in sentences to say what your plans are for the week.

## Time:

The preposition **pada** (in, on, at) and the verb **mau** (want to / going to) are used to say what you plan to do at a particular time.

For example:

*Pada jam 10 siang saya mau bersepeda.* At 10 o'clock, I am going cycling.

*Pada jam 11 siang saya mau berpiknik di taman.* At 11 o'clock, I am going for a picnic in the park.

*Pada jam setengah 2 siang saya mau berenang bersama Ardi.* At 1:30pm, I am going swimming with Ardi.

## Day:

To state your plans for the week more precisely, you can add in the day. This could be 'today' (*hari ini*), 'tomorrow' (*besok*) or another day, such as 'Monday' (*hari Senin*). These time words or phrases usually go at the beginning of the sentence.

For example:

*Hari ini, pada jam 10 siang, saya mau bersepeda.* Today, at 10 o'clock am, I am going cycling.

*Besok, pada jam 11 siang, saya mau berpiknik di taman.* Tomorrow, at 11 o'clock am, I am going for a picnic in the park.

- Notice that in these Indonesian examples there are commas before *pada*, and after the hour. In spoken Indonesian, there is a slight pause where these commas occur.
- If you wish to give a specific day as well as the time when you plan to do something, you must also put *pada* before the name of the day.

For example:

*Pada hari Selasa, pada jam setengah 2 siang, saya mau berenang bersama Ardi.* On Tuesday, at 1:30pm, I am going swimming with Ardi.
