

What do I need?

In Learning Object 2 'What will I wear?' you heard Zak telling Peter and Anna the items they need in order to do certain activities.

- To say what someone needs in order to do something, use the word **untuk**, which in the context of doing activities, means 'in order to'.
- You will learn other uses of *untuk* later.
- You have already learnt how to express needs in Module 4, Worksheet 3, by using the verb **membutuhkan** (to need).

Here are some examples you saw in Learning Object 2 that used *untuk* and *membutuhkan*

Untuk berenang kamu **membutuhkan** baju renang.

In order to go swimming, you need a swim suit.

Untuk bersepeda kamu **membutuhkan** T-shirt dan celana pendek.

In order to go cycling, you need a T-shirt and shorts.
