

Holding a party

There are many words in Indonesian that have been borrowed from other languages. The Dutch and Portuguese played an important role in Indonesia's history for hundreds of years. As a result, many words of Dutch and Portuguese origin have found their way into the Indonesian language. One example is the word **pesta** meaning 'a party' which has been borrowed from the Portuguese word *feira*. You may be more familiar with the Spanish version *fiesta*.

HOLDING A PARTY:

Mengadakan pesta means 'to hold a party'. Holding a party involves deciding on a date, a time, a venue and a guest list. Then you need to invite the guests. You could decide to send out written invitations.

As you know from Worksheets 1 and 2, the word for 'invitation' is **undangan**.

Notice that it is related to the verb **mengundang** (to invite). This is another example of how nouns are formed from verbs. (See Module 4, Worksheet 7 'Forming nouns from verbs'.)

Read this dialogue between Peter and Anna to see how these words are used. The dialogue is based on their conversation in Learning Object 2, 'You're invited'.

P: *Hei Anna, sebentar lagi hari ulang tahun kita!*

Hey, Anna! Soon it will be our birthday!

A: *Ya! Pada tanggal 9 Oktober. Mau mengadakan pesta?*

Yeah! On 9 October. Do you want **to hold a party**?

P: *Mau. Ayo! Kita **mengundang** Ardi dan Nina.*

Sure! Let's invite Ardi and Nina.

A: *Mau mengadakan pesta di apartemen?*

Do you want to hold the party in our apartment?

P: *Ya. Pada jam 3.*

Yeah! At three o'clock.

A: *OK. Ayo, kita menulis **undangan!***

OK. Come on, then. Let's write the **invitations!**
