LISTENING	
get text and follow it while listening listen to text more than once have to understand gist of text give selected information answer multiple choice questions tick right/wrong answers do fill-in/cloze exercises do matching exercises	listen only without access to text listen to text only once respond to the text give detailed information give the correct answer rewrite wrong answers do completion exercises explain words or find new context
SPEAKING	
	e.g using pictures or slides
name things use adjectives as predicates ask the other group questions match pictures with text on exercise sheet read answers	describe things use adjectives as attributes answer questions make dialogues make up questions
READING	
are provided with word definitions answer to simple questions answer to questions in English answer questions with access to text give English equivalent to LOTE words	have to understand words from context answer to more detailed questions answer to questions in the LOTE answer questions without access to text Give LOTE definitions/explanations of words/expressions in the text
WRITING	
	e.g. on studied topics
match LOTE questions with English translations write simple dialogues write simple text with words provided	match LOTE questions with LOTE answers write letter, diary entry in the LOTE write extended cohesive text utilizing vocabulary beyond that which is provided.
