Extended response (25%)

Requirements: Extended response

For each candidate, the extended response is undertaken in a single session, divided into two parts:

- Part 1: Analysing Indonesian texts in Indonesian — a prepared, individual, multimodal response to Indonesian stimulus texts
- Part 2: Exchanging information and ideas in Indonesian — an individual spoken response to unseen **open-ended** follow-up **questions** with the examiner.

Open ended Questions

Open ended questions encourage people to elaborate on a topic.

Listen for the topic in the question.

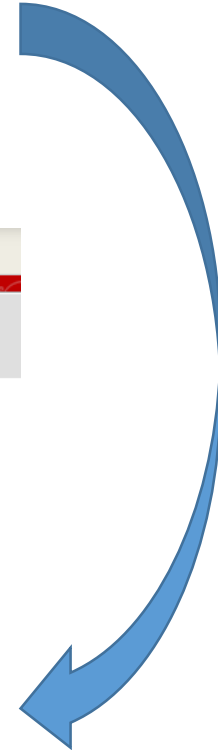
"**WHO**" are some of the people involved in the process...
"**WHAT**" is it that you want me to do...
"**WHEN**" is it possible for someone to be ready...
"**HOW**" can all the needs be met...
"**WHY**" do you think you made that decision...
"**EXPLAIN**" the ways we can use that...
"**TELL**" me some ways the group might...
"**GIVE**" me some reasons why this makes sense to you...
"**DESCRIBE**" what happened during the week before...

To elicit more information the examiner might say:

kapan / siapa / di mana / ke mana / berapa / apakah

Closed questions can become like open-ended questions with the addition of adverbs

Berapa sering kamu menggunakan HPmu?

Biasanya kamu makan dengan siapa?

Apakah kamu pernah ke Indonesia?

Did you notice *berapa sering* used in a previous question?

BERAPA can link with quite a few words e.g.

- **berapa?** – to ask about numbers, quantities, times and prices.

Contoh:	Berapa harganya?	How much is it?
	Berapa kali seminggu dia berlatih?	How many times a week does he train?
	Indonesia mendapatkan berapa medali?	How many medals did Indonesia win?
	Berapa derajat suhu sekarang?	What's the temperature now?
	Berapa tinggi Gunung Merapi?	How high is Mt. Merapi?
	Berapa panjang Sungai Ciliwung?	How long is the Ciliwung River?
	Berapa luas Kebun Raya itu?	How big are the Botanical Gardens?
	Berapa lebar jalan itu?	How wide is the road?

Technically these are closed questions.

Don't forget 'ADA' can be used in a question.

Ada berapa orang dalam keluarga kamu?

Ada siapa saja dalam kelas bahasa Indonesia kamu?

Ada berapa banyak aplikasi yang kamu pakai di HPmu?

Harap / Tolong / Silakan ... memperkenalkan dirimu.

Please introduce yourself / tell me about yourself.

Think of 5 things you can say about yourself.

RECITE / RECALL / APPLY

Sample response: Tolong memperkenalkan dirimu.

Kenalkan nama saya Jane Windi, anda/ibu/bapak bisa panggil saya Jane. Saya berumur tujuh belas tahun jadi saya sudah bisa mengemudi mobil sendiri. Itu asyik.

Saya tinggal di Downs bersama keluarga saya termasuk dua kakak perempuan. Saya bersekolah di Darling SHS dan kesibukan sehari-hari termasuk belajar, membantu ibu dan ngobrol bersama teman-teman di medsos.

Pada hari Kamis dan sabtu saya kerja di toko Target. Kesukaan saya termasuk makan, menonton dan naik kuda.
