- The Assembly instructions are divided into three blocks: A (head), B (body), and C (legs). Follow the instructions for each block to assemble your black rhinoceros.
- → mark is a basic assembly technique that remains the same regardless of the part. Instructions are printed only for the first instance.


- Keep scissors and glue away from small children.

Assemble the head


Use pattern: Page2 / Page3.

- 1 Cut out A1 by cutting along the lines.
- ★ Cut along the line marked ———





- 2 Make a valley fold on A1.
- ★ Trace along the valley fold line with a stencil pen, scoring it to make it easier to fold.







- 3 The parts will be easier to assemble if curled.
- ★ Using the photo as a guide, apply pressure with the palm of your hand, gradually curling the paper in the direction of the arrow.







- 4 Add a slight curl to A1 when attaching it.
- ★ Attach the triangular glue tabs so that the front side becomes convex.
- ★ Using the photo as a guide, attach in the direction of the arrow.






5 Attach A1 and A2, and attach A3 to them.







6 Attach A4 to the head.




Glue A5 and A6 together, and add a curve as you assemble them. Assemble A7 and A8 in the same way.







8 Attach the ears to the head.

10 Attach the horn to the head to complete the head.









1) Assemble B1, B2 and B3.







2 Attach B4 and B5, and attach them to B2 and B3.






3 Attach B6 and B7, and attach B8 to them.






4 Attach the buttock to the body.





5 Attach the head and the body to complete the body.






1) Assemble C1 and C2.






2 Attach C1 and C2 to the body.







3 Assemble C3, C4 and C5. In the same way, assemble C6, C7 and C8.







4 Attach C3, C4, and C5. In the same way, attach C6, C7 and C8.









(5) Assemble C9, C10 and C11. In the same way, assemble C12, C13 and C14.




6 Attach C9, C10 and C11. In the same way, attach C12, C13 and C14.

Without adding glue, fit the feet to the legs so that they stand on the ground. Next, attach them together with glue.





Attach C19 to the body, and your black rhinoceros is complete.
