

When, While and Whereas - conjunctions

Ketika and Waktu = when

ketika is more formal. Indicates that s.t. happened in the past or will happen

Waktu/ketika saya kecil keluarga saya tinggal di kota Surabaya.

When I was little my family live in Surabaya.

Kami sedang tidur waktu/ketika polisi datang ke rumah

We were sleeping when the police came to our house.

Ruth akan menelpon waktu/ketika sampai di Brisbane

Ruth will ring when she arrives in Brisbane.

Kapan - when = a question word - can only be used in a question

Kapan kamu pulang ? When are you going home ?

Kapan can never be used as a conjunction e.g.

Saya tinggal di Brisbane kapan saya kecil. I lived in Brisbane when I was little

Saya tinggal di Brisbane waktu/ketika saya kecil.

Sambil - while - one person two activities

refers to the same person or persons doing two things at the same time.

- *Ria sedang makan sambil menonton televisi. Ria is eating while watching television*
- *Sambil mandi dia menyanyi. While having a shower he sang*

Sedangkan - while, whereas, where in fact -

Used to contrast things - different people different activities different times

Jalan Browns Plains lebar dan bagus sedangkan Jalan Ivor sempit dan kotor.

Browns Plains Road is wide and neat/good whereas Ivor Street is narrow and dirty.

Saya senang makan pisang sedangkan kakak saya senang makan apel.

I love eating bananas while/whereas my brother lives eating apel.

Sementara - 2 or more people - separate activities - same time

Sulastri bernyanyi sementara Bambang bermain gitar.

Sulastra mentonton televisi sementara ibu masak di dapur.

Aktivitas: Using waktu, ketika, sedangkan, sambil, sementara or kapan complete the following:

- x) Tuti tertawa (laughed) temannya menangis.
